With a terroir-focused approach, Craggy Range works with some of the best areas in New Zealand: the Gimblett Gravels vineyard in Hawkes Bay and the Te Muna Road vineyard in Martinborough.

Tasting Note

Lovely aromas of citrus blossom, lime, jasmine and the faintest hint of fresh honey. Subtle flavours of fresh lime and grapefruit are balanced with a fine chalky texture that is reminiscent of the stones and limestone within the vineyard. Finishes dry, fresh and long.
